Aim of the Study visit

Under WP 3 Milestone 4 a Study visit should be organised for the Project Steering Committee and staff to a euroregion or working community, similar to ERB in that it consists of regions from a few countries, including one from outside EU.

The aim is to seek best practices and experience in management of joint policies related to JDP (particularly regional development, transport, environment and energy) by multilateral cooperation, with special foci on the set-up and functions of institutional structures.

The Study visit should been seen in the light of the Milestone 5 task with elaboration of a manual presenting ERB as a transferable model of constructing a euroregion, to be printed and disseminated.
