

# EUROREGION BALTIC ACTION PLAN 2013 -2014

Gdańsk, 26<sup>th</sup> February 2013

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## Background

Euroregion Baltic (ERB) Action Plan for 2013 – 2014 was adopted on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2013 at the beginning of the new presidency within the organisation assumed by the Danish regional Municipality of Bornholm. ERB stakeholders believe that biennial action plans are an effective tool enabling them to focus their efforts more precisely, to streamline their resources more efficiently and to concretise results they expect in a clearer manner. Such was the objective for this Action Plan, as well.

#### Goals

The ERB 2020 Agenda (adopted in 2010) provided the necessary strategic framework by defining the vision for Euroregion Baltic. According to the vision, in 2020 ERB will be a more dynamic tool to tackle common challenges observed by its members, and a strengthened political leverage in the cross-border cooperation of the Baltic Sea Region. Having analysed the implementation of the ERB Action Plan for 2012 and 2013, this Action Plan marks the first step in making the vision of the Agenda more attainable. Therefore, it recommends the activities which will contribute to the implementation of the two goals of ERB 2020 Agenda: making ERB an effective political tool, as well as making ERB efficient in dealing with common challenges.



#### Actions

The actions planned to help ERB stakeholders tackle common challenges take into account interests and ambitions proposed by the member organisations. These concern joint efforts aiming at supporting youth cooperation within the ERB Youth Board, fostering B2B cooperation with focus on clusters, innovation and SME internationalisation, building a platform to address labour market mobility and youth unemployment, and at cooperating around water related issues in the ERB regions. The actions designed in order to improve the political role of ERB are divided into external and internal ones. Externally, ERB will participate in the implementation of ETC and ENI programmes in the Baltic Sea Region, and in the implementation of the EU Strategy for the Baltic Sea Region, as well as cooperate with relevant actors at the EU, national and regional levels. Internal efforts will focus on the enhancement of the stakeholder approach and the enhancement of ERB internally.



## **Monitoring**

ERB Action Plan for 2013 – 2014 gives an outline of activities, each of which will require specific structure and framework that are impossible to define at the present moment and will have to be agreed at a later time. Therefore, the role of the ERB Executive Board is crucial in the regular monitoring of its implementation. The most important criterion while assessing and guiding the delivery of the planned results should be the level of their contribution to the goals of the ERB 2020 Agenda. Moreover, this Action Plan also indicates the source and size of the incoming joint resources, as well as their allocation and expenditure, which will be part of the monitoring activities by the ERB Executive Board.
