






One of the results of the CaSYPoT project is a re-organisation of the City Youth Council in the City of Slupsk, Poland. The City Youth Council now actively engages 23 members, who represent the city's youth. They come from different areas and schools, and participate in the local political life, Inspired by a Lithuanian project, the City of Slupsk is also developing an .
