The interest of the Programme members


- To build on the experience from previous Programme perspective;

 Programme








The interest of the Programme members

- The programme aims to introduce as many administrative and financial simplification as possible;
- the budget for the program is likely to be adopted at the similar level;
- Programme stakeholders are in favor of keeping comparable level of co-financing if regulations permit;
- the draft Cooperation Programme is going to be published for consultations in Autumn 2021;
- the Seed Money call is planned to be opened in September 2021.
